第一條 修業及休學年限：依本校學則規定辦理。

第二條 修業學分：

須修畢至少 30 學分，包括必修 18 學分(含碩士論文 6 學分及研究倫理 0 學分)及至少選修 12 學分(其中 6 學分須為本學院開設之課程)。

第三條 指導教授：

- 一、 本學程研究生於一年級上學期結束前選定指導教授，並繳交「指導教授選定書」。
- 二、 更換指導教授或共同指導教授，須填寫「指導教授變更書」。
- 三、 更換指導教授，必須同時更換研究題目，若有異議，可提至學程會議討論之。
- 四、 更換指導教授前須先與指導教授充份溝通。
- 五、 若已提出學位考試後不得更換指導教授。

第四條 論文計畫 (proposal) 審查：

- 一、 本學程研究生於二年級上學期結束前須提出論文計畫書審查。
- 二、 書面內容至少包括下列章節：Introduction (Including Significance)、Proposed Methods(Experiment Design)、Expected Difficulties、Expected Results。
- 三、 由指導教授組成三至五人之委員會進行口頭或書面報告審查，並進行學生學位論文專業領域審查。審查完畢後，將審查意見表送交學程辦公室備查。
- 四、 論文計畫書審查成績達七十分以上為通過，如未通過，須至少隔一個月方得重新提出申請。

- 五、 論文計畫書審查最遲應於申請學位考試前一學期之學期結束日之前(含)(學期結束日定義依學校行事曆規定)通過論文計畫書審查。
- 六、 若通過論文計畫書審查後更換指導教授或共同指導教授，則需重新進行論文計畫書審查。

第五條 學位考試：

- 一、 研究生於申請學位考試前須參加大型學術研討會/年會並發表論文至少乙次，學生於申請學位考試時一併檢附完成之佐證文件。
- 二、 碩士學位考試委員三至五名，由主任依指導教授建議名單圈選並指定一人為召集人，其中校外委員以三分之一為限，指導教授及共同指導教授以外委員應過半，且指導教授及共同指導教授不得擔任召集人，學位考試成績以七十分為及格。
- 三、 碩士學位考試委員推薦資格依本校「碩士及博士學位考試施行細則」辦理。
- 四、 碩士學位考試通過後，彙整委員意見，進行論文修改，依本校學位考試審查流程及畢業離校程序辦理，得予核發學位證書。

第六條 其他未盡事宜，悉依教育部與本校相關規定辦理。

第七條 本規定經教務會議通過，並報請校長後公告施行；修正時亦同。

Academic Regulations for the International Master's Program in Medical Neuroscience, Taipei Medical University

Amended and Passed in the International Master's Program in

Article 1 The duration of study and suspension: To be administered in accordance with the Taipei Medical University Academic Regulations.

Article 2 Graduation Credits:

Students in this program shall complete a minimum of 30 credits, including 18 credits of required courses (including 6 credits of master's thesis and 0 credit of Research Ethics) and at least 12 credits of elective courses (6 of the credits shall be the courses offered by our college).

Article 3 Advisor:

- I. Students in this program shall select their advisors during the first semester and hand in the "Advisor Selection Form."
- II. The "Advisor Change Form" shall be filled and turned in for the when changing an advisor or co-advisor.
- III. In case of advisor change, the research topic shall be changed at the same time. If there is any controversy, applications for discussions in the Program Academic Affairs Meeting shall be made.
- IV. Before changing the advisor, a student shall communicate with the advisor fully in advance.
- V. No advisor change shall be made after the application for master's degree examination.

Article 4 Thesis Proposal Review:

- I. Students in this program shall submit their proposals before the end of the first semester in their second year.
- II. A proposal shall contain the following sections: Introduction (Including Significance), Proposed Methods (Experiment Design), Expected Difficulties, and Expected Results.
- III. The advisor shall form an Examination Evaluation Committee consisted of three to five members to conduct the evaluation of an oral presentation or the review of a written report. They will also review the disciplines regarding the student's proposal. After the review, the review lists shall be forwarded to the department office for future references.
- IV. The passing grade of the proposal is 70 or above. If a proposal is failed, a student may reapply for a proposal review after at least a month.
- V. A student shall have his/her proposal passed before the last day

(depending on the school calendar) of the semester prior to the semester of the oral examination.

VI. If a student has his/her advisor changed after passing of the proposal, he/she shall submit a new proposal for review.

Article 5 Degree Examination

I. Graduate students shall present at least one article in a large-scale academic conference/annual conference. Students shall submit evidence of their presentations when applying for a degree examination.

II. There shall be an Examination Evaluation Committee, consisted of three to five members, established for the master's degree examination. The department chair shall select one person as the convener. One third of the committee members shall be the external committee member(s). The committee shall comprise of three to five members and one of them shall be the convener. The number of committee members shall be more than half of the total, other than the advisor and co-advisor. The advisor and co-advisor shall not be the convener. The passing grade of the degree examination is 70.

III. The qualifications of the recommendation of mater degree committee member shall be administer in accordance with the "Rules and Regulations of Master's and Doctoral Degrees Examination of Taipei Medical University."

IV. After passing the degree examination, revision to areas in thesis shall be completed according to suggestions from members of the degree examination committee. After the revision of the thesis, a candidate may apply for leaving the University in accordance with the degree examination procedure and graduation and school leaving protocol. A degree certificate shall be conferred accordingly.

Article 6 Matters not covered by these Regulations shall be handled in accordance with these Regulations and rules of the Ministry of Education and Taipei Medical University.

Article 7 These Regulations have been approved by the Academic Affairs Meeting and have been submitted to the President for approval and implementation. Amendments to these Regulations shall follow the same procedure.
